2). **Community Identity:** Gerrie and Lynn worked very hard to get a grant for street banners for Rolando Park, down College Avenue and along University to 70th. These should be up within a year!

3). **Code Compliance:** Neighbors have been advised to pay attention to what they see around the neighborhood, and we have had speakers to educate us about what is and isn't acceptable in our community.

4). **Trash in Zena Canyon:** We have a thorough canyon clean-up twice a year of the canyon, and once a month, the Lean and Clean volunteers clean up the trash at the top.

5). **Planting Drought Tolerant Trees:** We had lively speakers on this topic, and information is available on the city website and Nextdoor.

6). **Homeless** in the area: Gerrie Flaven is the liaison with Officer Terry Hoskins regarding this; please contact her.

Sonia reminded us that we'll do new goal setting in January.

Debbi announced that we've received more memberships with our mail-in drive, and now are up to 70! Getting closer to the goal of 100!

After almost another hour of energetic voices filling the room, the party of about 40 people came to an end.
