City Water & Sewer Work on the 6300 Block of Celia Vista Drive

As part of the City's Water and Sewer Project 940, the sewer pipes in the 6300 block of Celia Vista Drive will be dug up and replaced with new pipes. The contractor will also install new laterals at no cost to homeowners.

The project on this block may begin as soon as the next 2 weeks, depending on the Contractor's progress on the College Ave. project. It will last 6 weeks to 2 months.

Those of us who lived on this street during the utility undergrounding project within the last 10 years know that the construction can be inconvenient and very messy (think lots of dust), but that the finished product, including the newly surfaced street, will be a big improvement for our block.

We won't be able to park on the street while the crews are working. Residents will be able to access their homes and park in their driveways. The work crews will need to park their equipment on the street.

Door hanger notices should be provided about 5 days before construction begins and "no parking" notices 72 hours before.

The contractor is TC Construction, Inc. who are local specialists in these kinds of infrastructure projects.
